Mont Orford has enlarged its ski chalet, added an outside agora and installed a magic carpet (entirely covered), augmenting its many (and varied) ski facilities.

Mont SUTTON has upgraded its snowmaking and trail maintenance system and added a coffee bar and restaurant at the base of the mountain. They will be open in time for the fall colours and will remain so through to the spring ski season!

Owl's Head has also upgraded its snow-making system and it has completely renovated its ski chalet. Skiers can enjoy spectacular views over Lake Memphremagog, as well as a new selection of gourmet food.
