FORESTA LUMINA

Located in Parc de la Gorge de Coaticook, <u>Foresta Lumina</u> is an illuminated trail to be explored by night. It holds beauty and mystery—not to mention the longest pedestrian bridge in North America and mythical creatures that are sure to delight visitors young and old. This internationally acclaimed Moment Factory masterpiece is a must-see!

ASTROLAB

Parc National du Mont-Mégantic's <u>ASTROLab</u> is a science centre dedicated to astronomy. It features two exhibit rooms, a projection room and two observatories located at the top of the mountain. Both research centre and tourist attraction, it offers plenty of enriching activities, including guided visits. It is open year round and is a great way to discover the mystery of the cosmos while admiring the beauty of the night sky. Bonus: The park is the world's first Dark Sky Preserve.

GRANBY Z00

Offering ample opportunity for educational family fun, the zoo is one of the region's most popular attractions. Not only is it home to 225 species but it also boasts a water park, amusement park and dinosaur park (!). It's true: Dinozoo features 21 life-sized animatronic dinosaurs.
